Cruz Avenue. Go three blocks to Nicholson. Turn right to start/finish.

Parking: Racers and visitors, please do not park in any merchant lots!! Please use the Park & Ride lot north of

Highway 9, public lots, and the street parking outside of the course.

Course: Same course as always with newly laid concrete! Tait-Bean-Massol-Nicholson/Ellenwood-Belmont-

Bachman-Tait, clockwise one-mile loop with the Start/Finish line at Tait and Nicholson. One very steep Climb (23%), five 90° right turns and one 90° left turn. Free lap rule applies; bring your own wheels.

Registration: Registration will be available on <u>BikeReg.com</u>. Pre-registration closes at 5pm Wednesday, March 22, 2023.

Onsite registration is available on race day if fields are not full, \$10 day-of surcharge. Cash or check only.

2nd race qualifies for a discounted registration fee of \$15, applied to lower cost race. Race registration opens at 7:30AM and closes 15 minutes before each scheduled race start.
